

TECHNICAL BULLETIN 3

This technical bulletin outlines modifications regarding equipment control at the upcoming 2018 Commonwealth Junior and Cadet Fencing Championships.

General Rules:

- Except where specifically stated, the events are organized and run in accordance with current FIE Rules for Competition; the Directoire Technique is empowered to make changes at short notice to the rules in order to ensure the smooth running of the Championships; as such, requirements pertaining to weapon check have been modified as follows:
 1. Fencers must wear their name and national symbol on the back of their jacket (dark blue capitals, 8-10 cm in height); clothing and all personal equipment must comply with the current FIE rules for World Cup events and a control of the following items will take place: masks, all lamé equipment, wires and weapons, and, to ensure the smooth running of the competition, clothing, to verify that it complies with FIE rules and that National identification stripes/symbols, names and country abbreviation are being worn in conformity with the rules. Referees on the piste will check for control marks.
 2. National colours (for UK fencers, these are not GBR) on both legs
 3. Any fencer involved in medal presentations must wear a track suit bearing his/her National identification.
